## 2019 Narratives

Total revenues were up to budget in the fourth quarter of 2019 by \$78k or 7.1%. The increase in food and beverage revenues of \$31k or 3.7% were related in large part to the Festival of Trees event, which exceeded their budgeted revenues, by \$40k. Rental revenues exceeded budget by \$32k or 18.8% as we booked two dance groups (\$20k) and a police-recruiting exam (\$10k) in the year for the year.
